**Ordinance # 562,**

**Winter Time Hours For Parking**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WINTER TIME HOURS FOR PARKING VEHICLES OR OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY ON ANY CITY STREETS, EASEMENTS, RIGHT OF WAYS AND ALLEYWAYS DURING WINTER MONTHS; CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED; THREE READING RULE WAIVED; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AS OF THE DATE OF PASSAGE.

**Section 1: Recitals.**

*Whereas*, the City Council passed Ordinance #562 restricting winter time parking; and

*Whereas*, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Montpelier to amend Ordinance #562 to allow the City to alter the hours for winter parking due to snow removal on City streets and alleyways.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF MONTPELIER, IDAHO, THAT ORDINANCE #562 BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 2: Amended Ordinance 10.08.031.** No person shall cause any vehicle or any other personal property to be parked, placed or left on any street, alley, easement or right of way located in the City of Montpelier, County of Bear Lake, State of Idaho between the hours of ~~1 a.m. and 6 a.m.~~ 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. during the winter months of November, December, January, February and March.


All other aspects and Sections of Ordinance #562 shall remain intact.

**Section 3: Conflicting Ordinances Repealed.** If any part of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid by the decision of any court or regulatory body of competent jurisdiction, such shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


**Section 4: Reading Requirements of Idaho Code §50-902.** One half (1/2) plus one (1) of the members of the full council agree to dispense with the rule requiring the reading of this ordinance on three (3) separate occasions.

**Section 5: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, and publication as provided by law.
